As representatives of our unit PTAs, we will want to create a good impression. Some guidelines for creating those positive impressions and getting the most from this experience are:

- Dress is business attire Tuesday - Thursday
 - Guys - Dress shirts and ties or "Polo shirts", slacks (no jeans), socks, dress shoes (no tennis shoes and no hats)
 - Gals - Dresses, skirts/slacks (no jeans) with coordinating top, dress shoes, and no hatsKeep an eye on the weather. It is often colder and wetter in Sacramento.

Exception to the rule: Casual wear may be worn while at the hotel during free time only.

- Remember you will be going through security both at the airport and at the Capitol. Leave any questionable items at home.
- You must arrive at least 2 hours before scheduled flight time with a picture identification reflecting the same name as it appears on the ticket.
- Do bring your cameras.
- You may want some spending money for souvenirs and snacks.
- Keep in mind that this isn't a vacation for shopping, seeing movies, etc. We are in Sacramento to learn and to work.
