1. The name of the unit, council and district **MUST** be on all displayed material.
2. Each council is responsible for bringing, setting up and removing their own display.
3. Exhibits may be set up between 8:30 a.m. and 9:15 a.m. only. **“No one will be permitted to set up after 9:15 a.m.”**.
4. Bring all supplies needed to mount posters etc. There will be one table per council.
5. The judging committee will select items from this display, based on the Thirty-Third District PTA “Exhibits” guidelines, that may be taken to the State Convention. These items will be marked with a Thirty-Third District PTA award.

Exhibits:

- Are ways of displaying and communicating messages visually
- May be posters, flyers, portfolios, photographs, collages, 3D assemblages etc.
- Promote PTA, special events, activities, projects and parent and/or student education programs.

Guidelines:

All exhibits must comply with basic PTA Objects and Basic Policies!!!!

- ✓ Try to follow a theme. Simplicity is the key to being most understandable and most attractive.
- ✓ Be original. **Strictly observe copyright laws.**
- ✓ Properly identify all exhibits. Name of unit, council and district should appear on each item.
- ✓ There must be **no periods in PTA or PTSA.**

When exhibits are displayed at Thirty-Third District PTA Annual Meeting, they will be judged according to the following criteria and many maybe proudly displayed at the Leadership Workshops.

Judging Criteria:

- Can it be transported easily? Posters may not be larger than 28” by 34”, or within those limits when folded.
- Are 3D centerpieces/art objects able to be transported safely?
- Are multi-page, detailed projects assembled well, in folders?
- Is the exhibit original? Unusual? Effective communication?
- Have PTA Objects and District Guidelines been followed?
